Luther King House Library is a well-stocked and up-to-date theological library containing over 30,000 books on all topics related to religion and theology (mainly Christianity), as well as a large collection of current journals, electronic resources and a computing suite.

According to our Mission Statement, we aim to support, facilitate, encourage and enable education, research, learning and personal development within Luther King House and throughout the whole church.

Facilities:

- Quiet study space
- Long opening hours
- Flexible deals for external memberships
- Fully qualified and knowledgeable staff on hand to provide help and support
- Computing suite with free internet access, printing and wifi
- Access to an online catalogue
- Access to online databases and electronic books to help with research and study
- A postal loan service for members who live outside of the Manchester area
- Guided reading programmes (by arrangement)

If you want flexible access to a great collection of resources to help you with sermon preparation, ministry, study or research, or you simply want to keep up to date with current issues in the church or read for your own interest and spiritual development, then the library can help you!

To join the library for reference use, the fee is £20.00 for 12 months (£12.00 concession for the unwaged and those in receipt of a pension, but not for students).

If you wish to borrow material from the library, the fee is £40.00 for 12 months (£25.00 concession). You are entitled to borrow up to six items for a period of three weeks. Items can be renewed indefinitely by phone, online or by email if they are not required by anyone else.

We also offer memberships of less than 12 months, and the fees are reduced accordingly. This is particularly helpful if you are on a tight budget or if you want to use the library during a sabbatical or period of study leave.

If you would like to join Luther King House Library, please contact us to arrange an initial appointment. You will need to pay your joining fee and complete a registration form on your first visit. We will give you a full tour of the library and explain how you can find what you need.

If three or more people from the same church or organisation wish to join at the same time, half price membership applies from the third person onwards.
